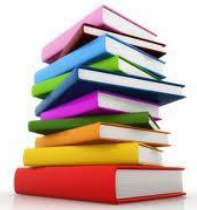

Have to do homework on your Chromebook but your Internet is down? The library offers high speed wireless for all patrons to utilize whether you are a card-holder or not. We have study tables for individual work or a Program Room that can be reserved for studying or group projects.

Need a book for your next genre book report or for a class assignment? Our staff is ready to help find your next book and if we do not have it, we can order it in from another library. We can also demonstrate how to use our e-book platforms to find the titles you need if you prefer to read content on your favorite device.

Are you stressing about your new AP class or about having to take the SAT? Registered patrons have access to our newest online resource, LearningExpress, which provides you with tutorials, e-books, flashcards, and practice tests that simulate the official exams. In addition, LearningExpress offers job search and workplace skills improvement, skill building in reading, writing, math, and basic science, career certification and licensure exam prep, college and grad school entrance test prep, GED® test prep, and more.

Is learning a foreign language frustrating you? Our Rocket Languages online resource is your tool for success with over 15 different languages to study. Registered patrons can improve their language skills with every lesson by taking part in the modern, everyday conversations that make up the Interactive Audio Course. In addition, you will learn to speak the language naturally with the language and culture lessons, and you can also build on your vocabulary and improve your audio recognition of common words and phrases with the popular Master Games range.
